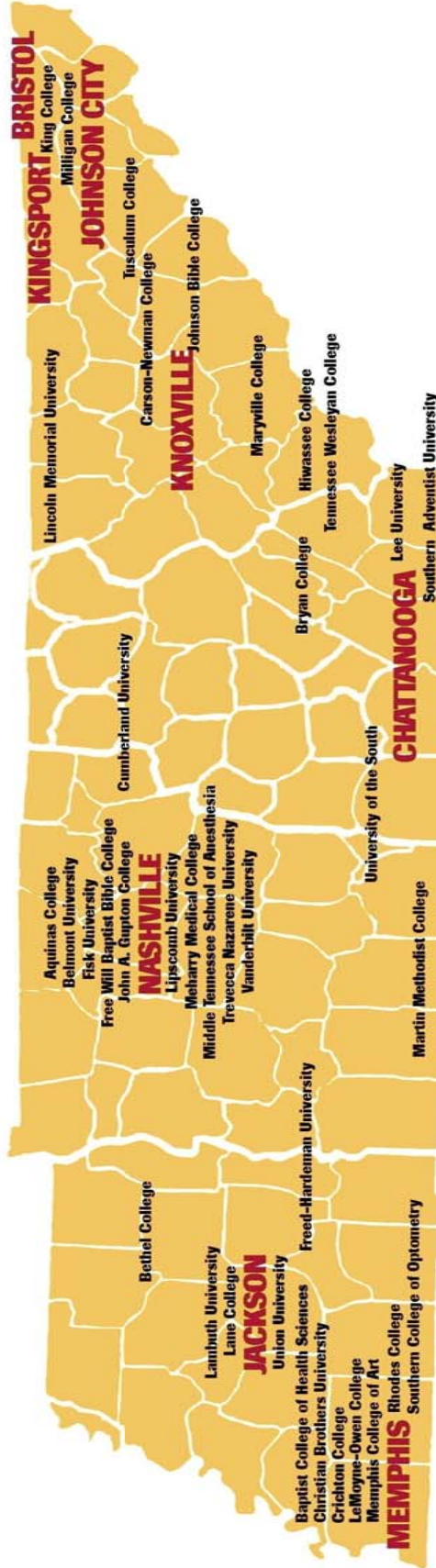

## 2004 Highlights

---

### Enrollment by Headcount

- **TICUA institutions enrolled 23% of the college students in Tennessee in fall 2004.**
- **Fall 2004 enrollment at TICUA member institutions increased 4% from the previous year (from 57,616 to 60,139)—an all time record high.**
- **In fall 2004, TICUA colleges and universities enrollment (60, 139) was 29% higher than the University of Tennessee System (42,597).**
- **Nearly 60% of the total enrollment at TICUA member colleges and universities are female.**
- **About 22% of the undergraduate enrollment at TICUA member colleges and universities are non-white.**
- **A quarter (25%) of the graduate and first professional students attending TICUA member institutions are enrolled part-time.**

### Enrollment by Full-time Equivalency (FTE)

- **Fall 2004 FTE was 56, 145 - also up 4% from the previous year and an all time high for TICUA member campuses.**

### Tuition and Fees

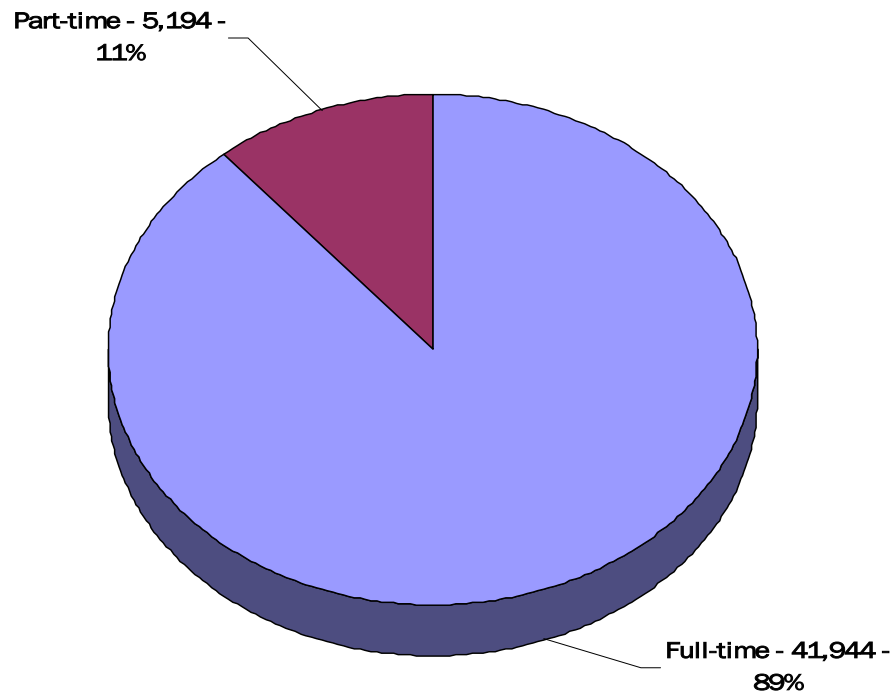
- **2004-05 tuition and fees at TICUA four-year member colleges and universities averaged 30% less than the national average (\$14,095 compared to \$20,082).**

### Degree Completion

- **TICUA member colleges awarded 36% of the state's bachelor's degrees, 38% of the state's master's degrees, 38% of the state's doctoral degrees and 47% of the state's first professional degrees in 2003 - 2004.**

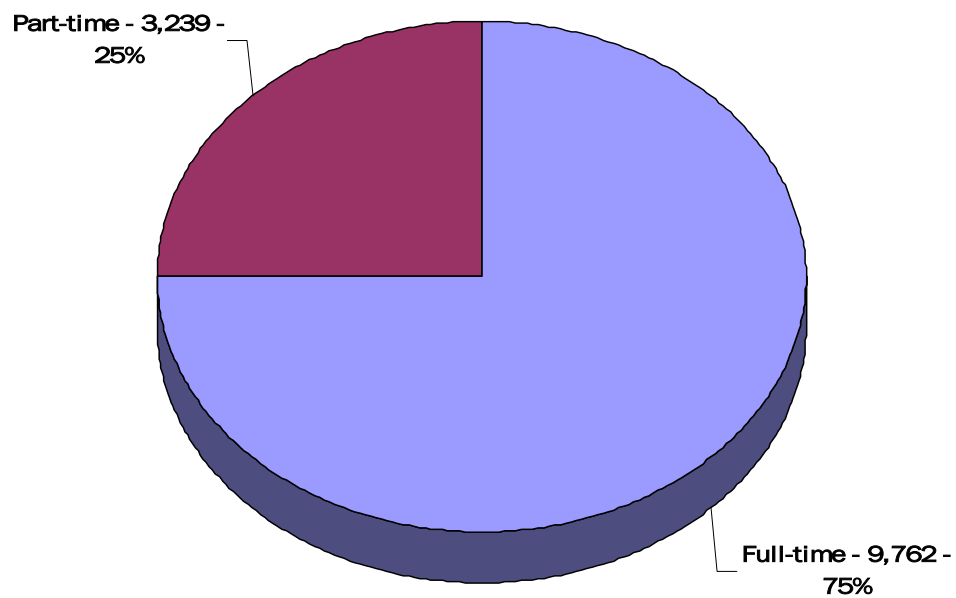
**Figure 1: Fall 2004 Enrollment by Headcount, by Attendance Status - Undergraduate**

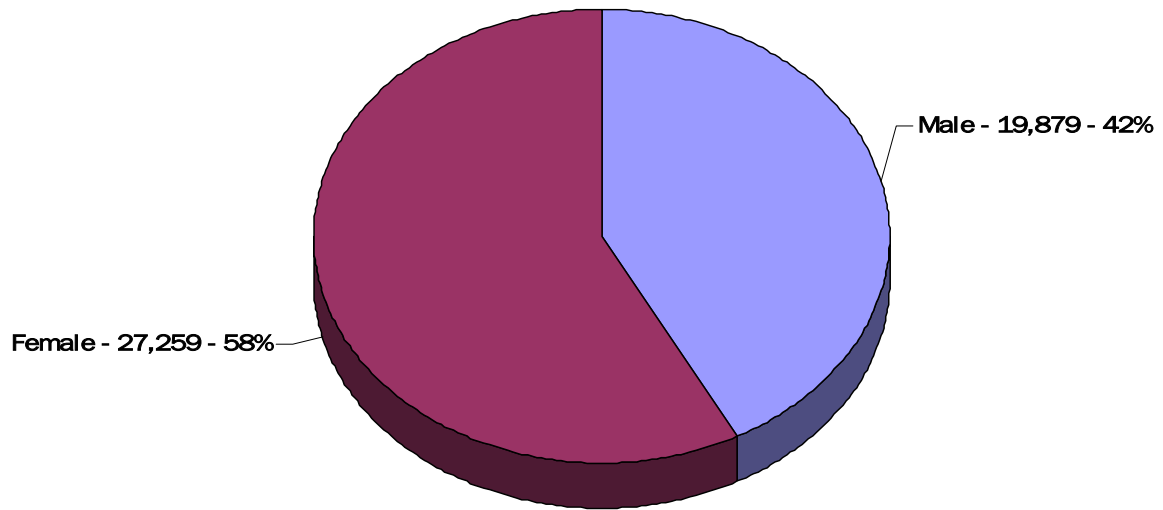
**Figure 2: Fall 2004 Enrollment by Headcount, by Attendance Status - Graduate and First-Professional**

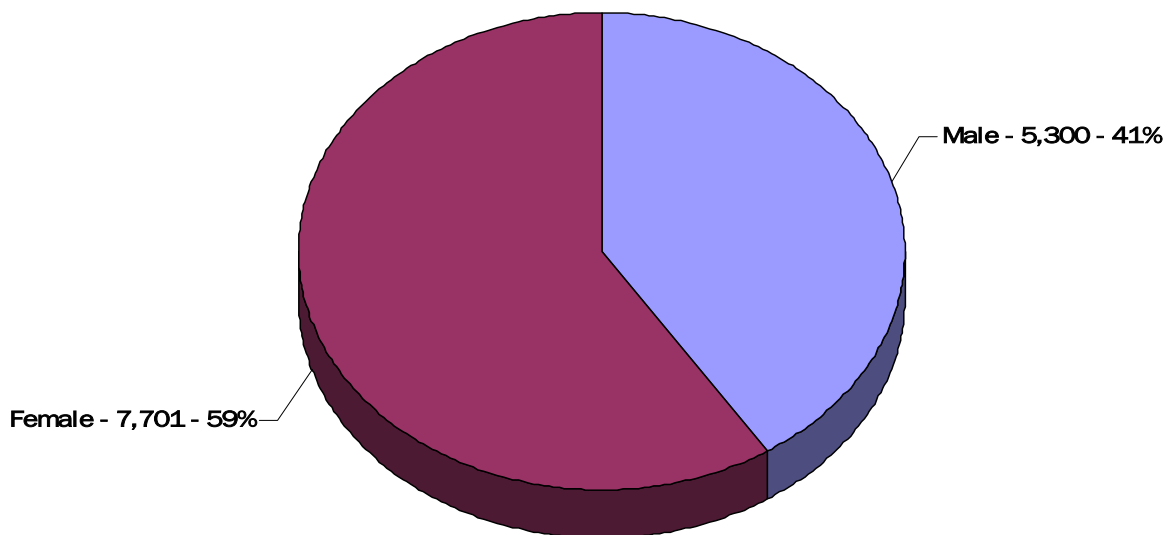
**Figure 3: Fall 2004 Enrollment by Headcount, by Gender - Undergraduate**

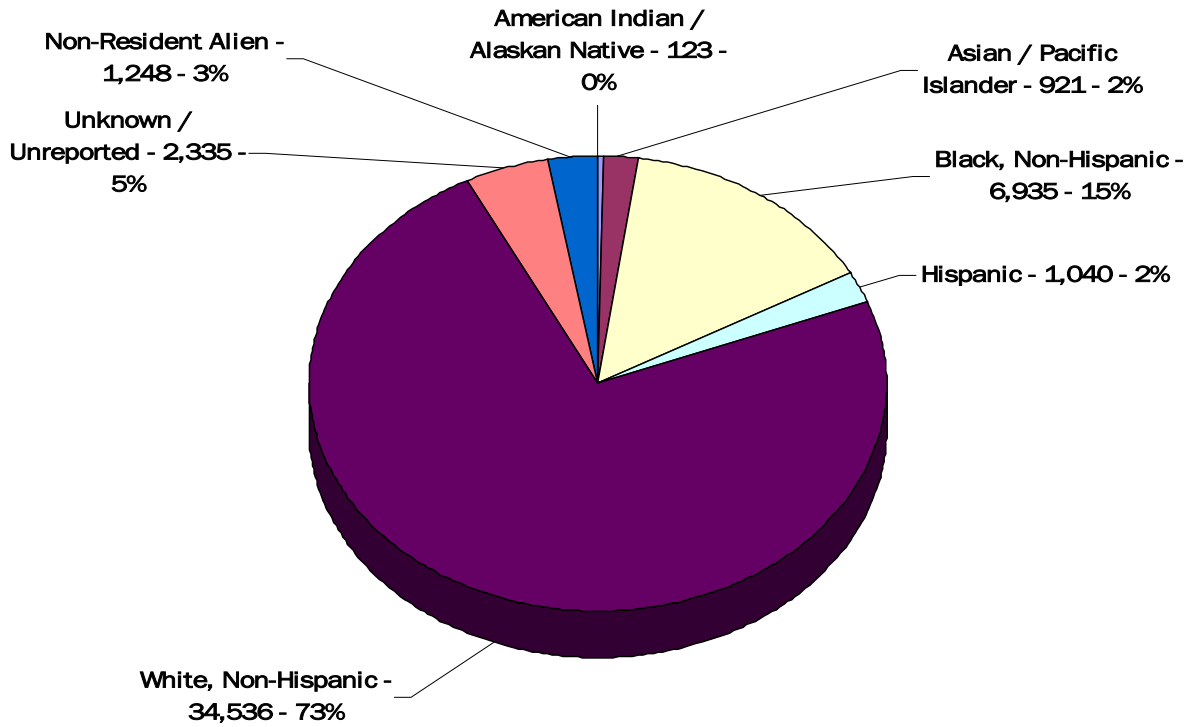


**Figure 4: Fall 2004 Enrollment by Headcount, by Gender - Graduate and First-Professional**

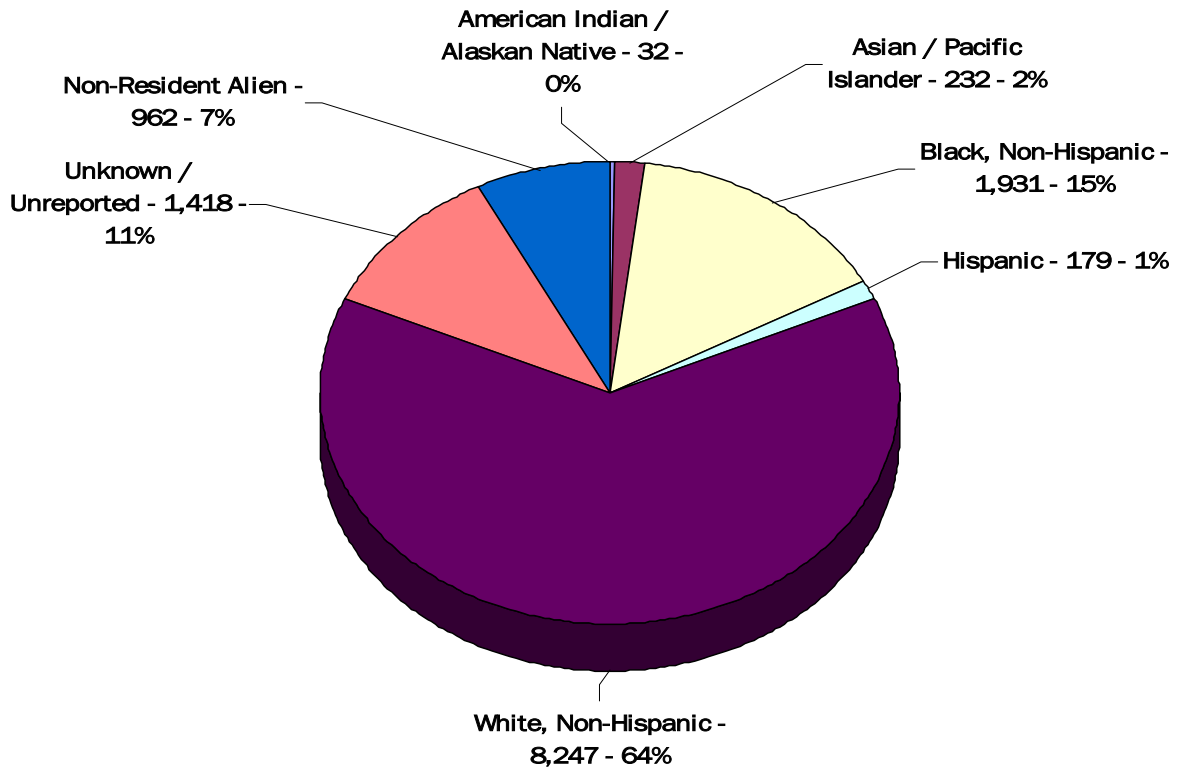

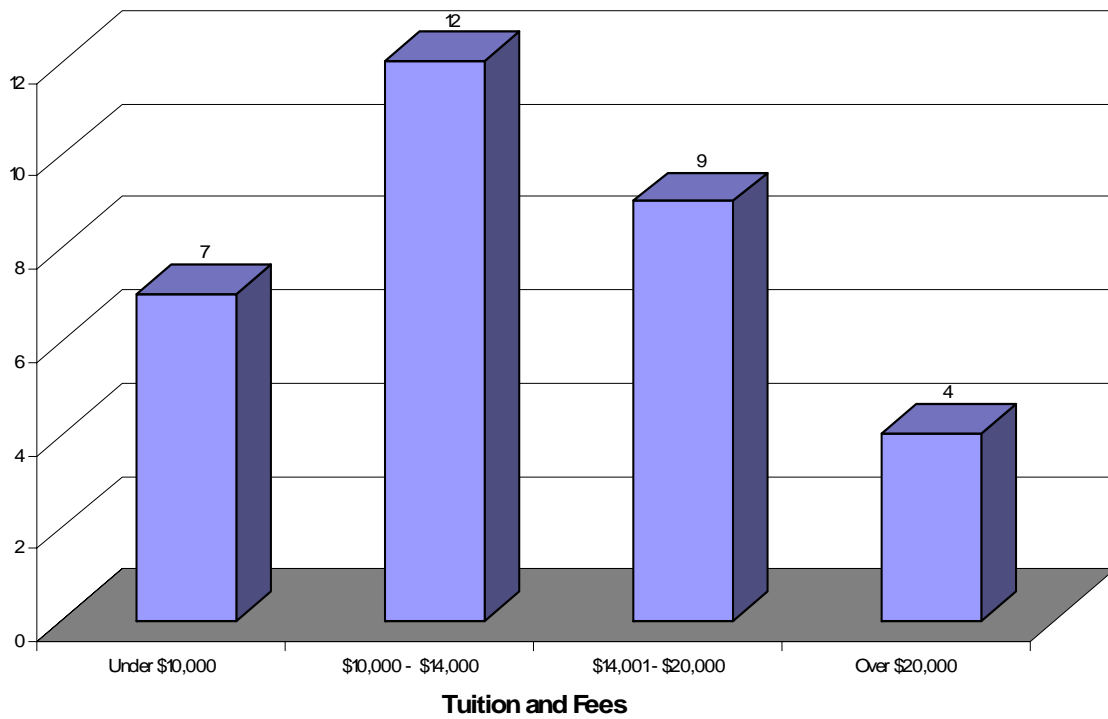
**Figure 5: Fall 2004 Enrollment by Headcount, by Ethnicity - Undergraduate**

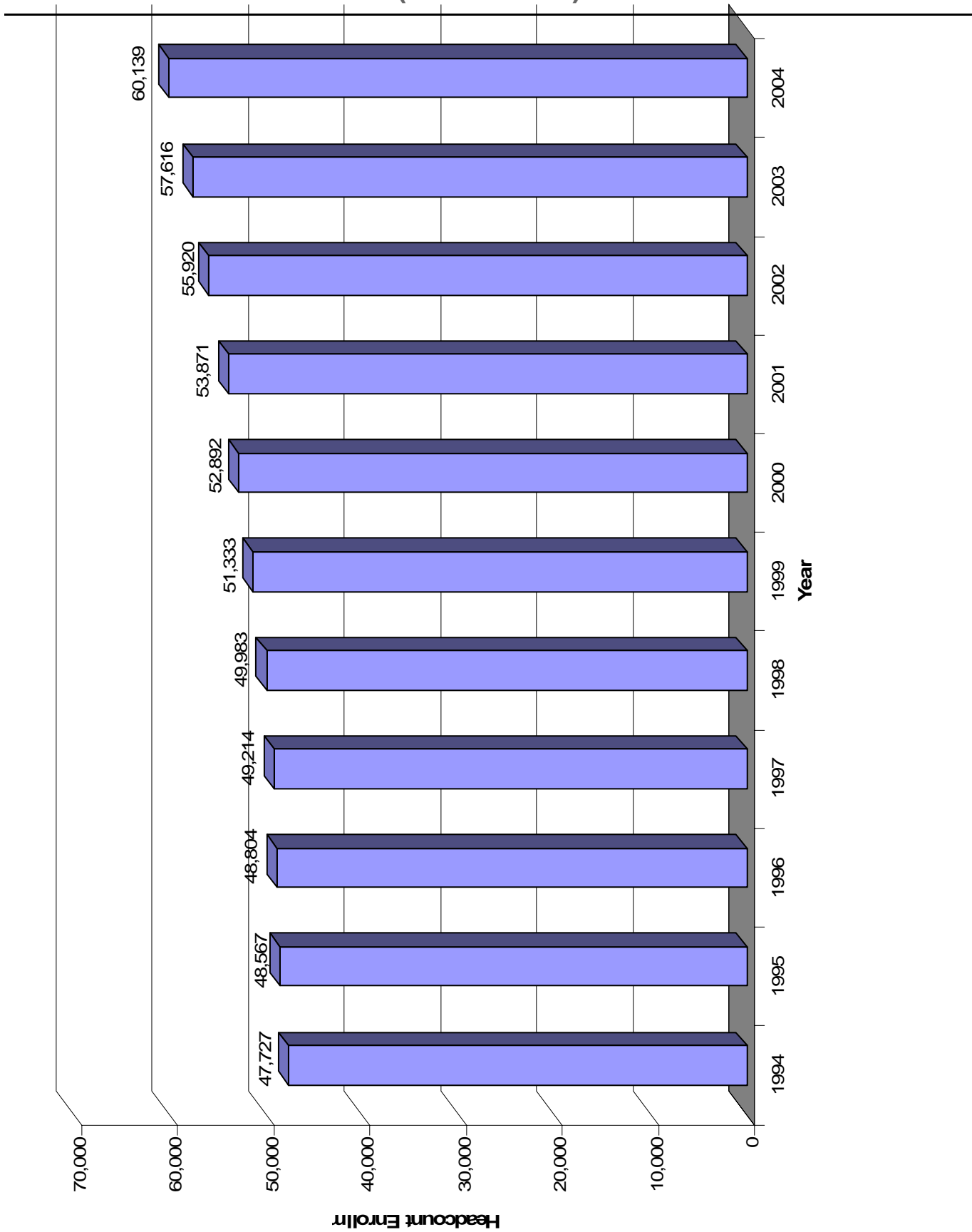

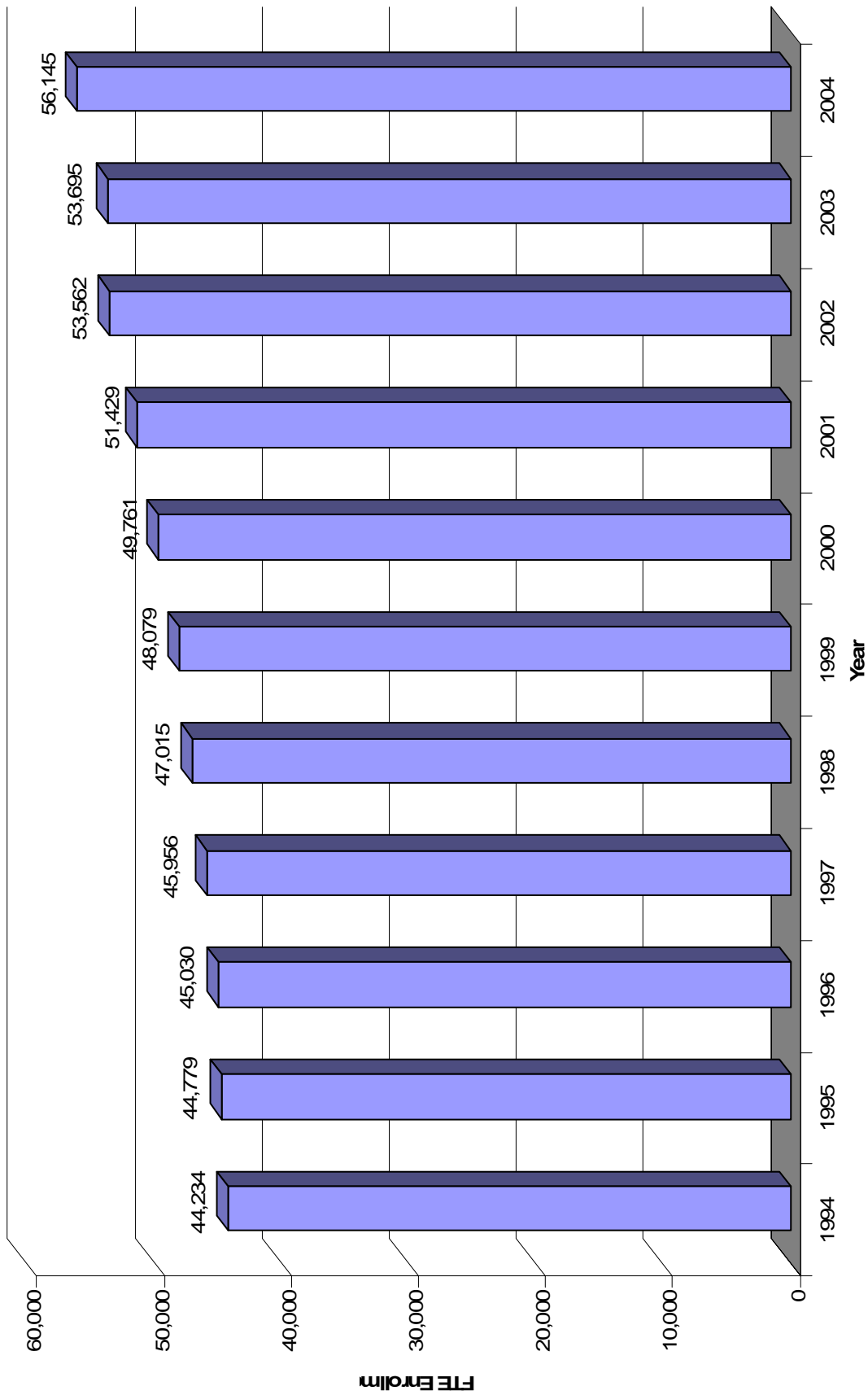

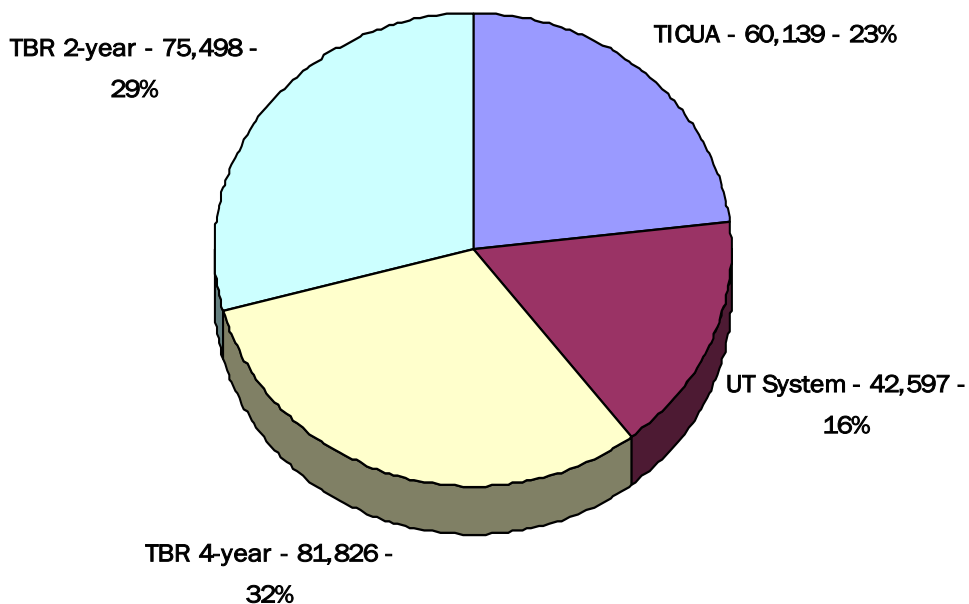


**Figure 11: Fall 2004 Enrollment by Higher Education Sector**

**Figure 12: Fall 2004 Enrollment Share by Higher Education Sector**

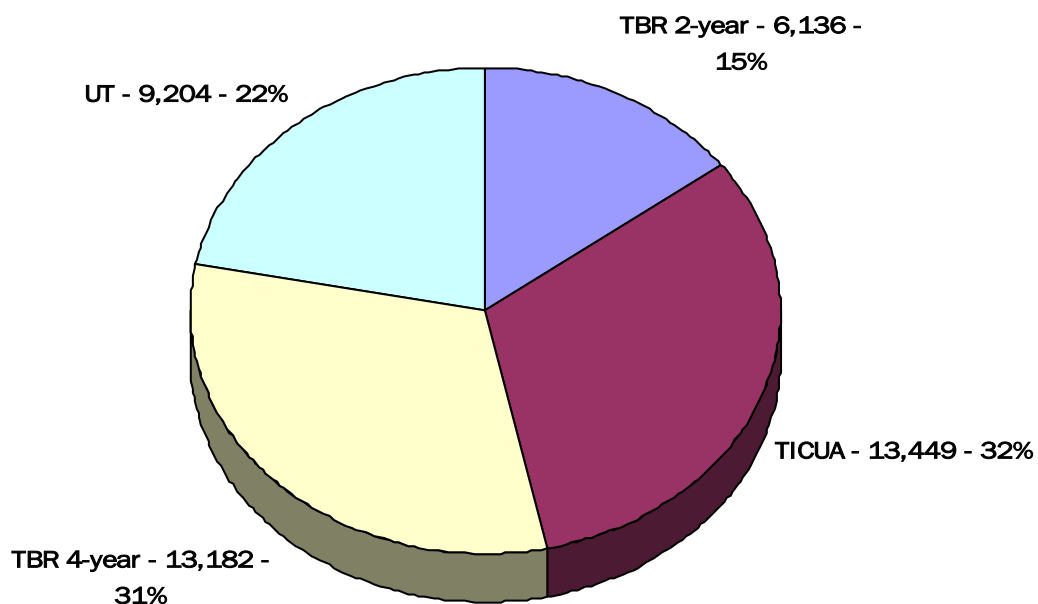
